New Occupational Lead Poisoning Prevention Fee Rates Effective January 1, 2025

The California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) recently approved new Occupational Lead Poisoning Prevention Fee rates effective January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. We are required to adjust the fee rates annually to reflect increases or decreases in the cost of living during the prior fiscal year, as measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) issued by the California Department of Industrial Relations.¹
